The museum is completed with the **Las Meninas Collection** and the **ceramics**, gifts from Jacqueline.

#### Suggestions

Another famous artist related with the city was **Joan Miro**. Maybe it's in your interest to know more about his work:

– **Foundation Joan Miró Museum**: It is located on the Montjuïc mountain. It was also a specific wish of the painter, including its location: if Barcelona was going to have a Miró Museum it was either in that place or nowhere. We can find paintings and works of Miró all around the city and here we can understand **its symbolism**. Once we understand it, we will understand Miro's world.
